




Relocation

- ✓ No one will be displaced
- Right to return to the same apartment (This will be provided in writing)
- Relocation specialists will meet with you to create an individualized family relocation plan
- Property will **remain** under NYCHA Management (Section 9)
- Rents will not go up as a result of this work
- All reasonable moving expenses will be provided or paid for by NYCHA

SNRP will host a dedicated Relocation Meeting to discuss relocation in detail and answer relocation-related questions.



Hazardous Materials Abatement

- Removal of all lead-based paint in apartments and common areas
- Removal of all mold in apartments and common areas
- Making your home a safe and healthy place to live




Full Kitchen Renovation

- New Sink and Faucet
- Countertops and full backsplash
- Fresh coat of paint
- Upgraded stainless steel appliances like fridges and electric stoves
- New cabinets and floors
- LED lighting



Ventilation




Repair/Replace or add ventilation systems to improve indoor air quality and circulation to promote healthier living environment

Prevent the growth of mold and remediate the root causes of current mold growth in each apartment








Full Plumbing and Electrical Upgrades

- Full plumbing replacement*
- Essential electrical upgrades to better serve current electrical needs
- Addition of more electrical outlets for increased safety and convenience

*Saint Nicholas was rated one of the top 20 developments for the worst plumbing systems in NYCHA





Elevators

Complete replacement of all elevators to ensure better and more reliable service.

10 Elevators to be replaced under existing contract to fast track those in most need: Buildings 1,3,7,9, and 11 to be completed by NYCHA



18 Elevators to be replaced under Comp Mod Project: Buildings 2,4,5,6,8,10,12,13 and 14 to be completed by SNRP

Heating and Hot Water Upgrades

- Brand new heating and hot water systems
- Fully electric system that provides both heating and cooling with individual controls
- Reduced environmental impact with fully electric system
- Ensuring consistent, reliable heat and hot water service to all residents
- Ensuring the proper storage of hot water to provide safe water quality standards in all buildings in coordination with NYCHA's Healthy Homes Office of Water Quality





Window and Building Exterior Upgrades

- Replacement of **all** windows throughout the development
- Repairs and restoration of all brickwork
- New exterior wall cladding (EIFS) to prevent water intrusion and provide better insulation to keep buildings warm in the winter and cool in the summer.





Pest and Waste Management

- New exterior waste yard improvements to better handle waste
- Comprehensive sealing of apartments to prevent pests
- ✓ New recycling rooms



Next Steps

- You will see SNRP team members on-site conducting inspections as part of the design process and keeping residents updated.
- SNRP will schedule a Relocation Meeting at a later date this summer to discuss relocation in detail and answer relocation-related questions.
- Vote for your favorite kitchen and bathroom material finishes! Voting open through June 28th.
- After votes are tallied, SNRP will construct a model unit with the winning finishes for you to visit and see what your apartments will look like post-construction.




